



The majority of Greater Vancouver's water has a low pH, alkalinity and mineral content meaning it is very soft water.

Studies show detergent use can be reduced by 50% and energy saved by washing in 16°C (60°F) cold water instead of 38°C (100°F) hot water, achieving the same or better stain removal and whiter clothes compared to results in hard water.

The reduced detergent will also prevent washing machine service calls due to disproportionate soap use in a soft water environment. If you are unsure of your water's alkalinity contact your Regional District to verify.
